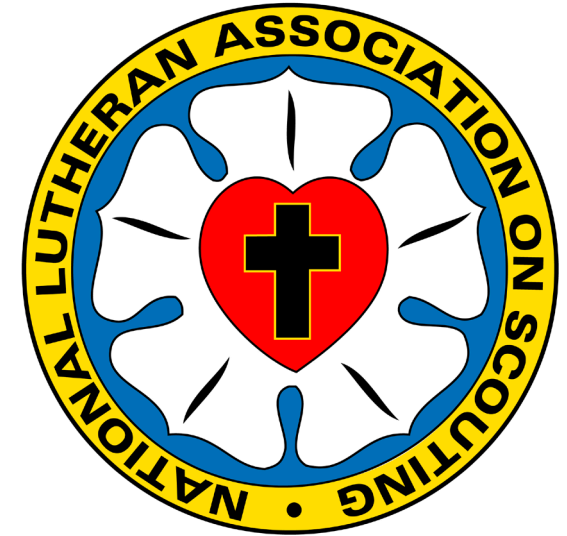

That all Lutheran young people and others in youth agency programs used by Lutheran congregations, as well as their families, are exposed to Jesus Christ, and have an opportunity to know him as Lord and Savior

What NLAS Does...

- It encourages Lutheran youth members of civic youth-serving agencies to grow in the knowledge of the Triune God and in their relationships to the Lutheran church bodies through Religious Growth Programs endorsed by the Lutheran church bodies,
- It fosters the organization and growth of local Lutheran Associations, Lutheran Committees on Scouting and like groups,
- It sponsors meetings of the membership each year,
- It encourages Lutheran congregations to make use of civic youth-serving agency programs and resources as a means of extending their youth ministry and community outreach,
- It promotes the use of unit and camp chaplains and chaplain aides,
- It fosters other relationship and programs approved by NLAS and the various Lutheran church bodies.

Who can join NLAS?

Membership in NLAS is open to persons who are:

- Members of Lutheran congregations,
- Leaders and members in one or more of the civic youth serving agencies with which NLAS cooperates,
- Youth members of one of the cooperating scouting organizations, or
- Other persons subscribing to and wishing to further the purposes of NLAS.



Why join NLAS?

Membership in NLAS adds your voice and efforts in promoting the working witness of Jesus Christ in service to the civic youth-serving agencies. NLAS works closely with youth ministry leaders of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America and The Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod to develop, maintain, and promote mutual efforts and programs. NLAS is represented on the Boy Scouts of America National Religious Relationships Committee. Members receive regular communication on various ways to share the message of Jesus Christ.

How do I join NLAS?

Just complete the attached application and mail it with your tax deductible contribution, as shown in the following paragraph, to the address indicated. Upon receipt, we will send you a packet of information to help you with the role in which you choose to serve. A membership card will also be mailed to you to confirm your support for this important ministry to Lutheran Congregations. The term of membership runs from June 1 through May 31 of the following year. Regular membership is \$20, a couple may join together for \$30, and \$10 for youth. We also offer a life membership for \$350, or you can get a partial life membership for five yearly payments of \$75 per year.)
